**STATE BOARD OF MEDICINE TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

**BOSTON:** At its meeting today the state Board of Registration in Medicine took disciplinary action against the medical license of Sergey Wortman, M.D.

The Board reprimanded Dr. Wortman. The Board found that he billed a health insurance provider for medical services which were in fact provided by a physician employed by him. Dr. Wortman has reimbursed the insurer for all funds inappropriately paid to him. Dr. Wortman is a 1978 graduate of Leningrad Sanitary and Hygienic Medical Institute. He is board certified in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, and has been licensed to practice medicine in Massachusetts since 1997.

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Medicine licenses more than 30,000 physicians, osteopaths and acupuncturists. The Board was created in 1894 to protect the public health and safety by setting standards for the practice of medicine and ensuring that doctors who practice in the Commonwealth are appropriately qualified and competent.
