**STATE BOARD OF MEDICINE TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

**BOSTON:** At its meeting today the state Board of Registration in Medicine took disciplinary action against the medical license of Chin-Shee Chong, M.D.

The Board accepted the resignation of Dr. Chong's license to practice medicine. Resignation is a disciplinary action that permanently removes a physician from practice. Dr. Chong is a 1963 graduate of the National Defense Medical School in Taiwan. He is a General Practitioner and has been licensed to practice in Massachusetts since 1984.

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Medicine licenses more than 38,000 physicians, osteopaths and acupuncturists. The Board was created in 1894 to protect the public health and safety by setting standards for the practice of medicine and ensuring that doctors who practice in the Commonwealth are appropriately qualified and competent.
